The first time you access your Google Calendar in your school Google account, it may be displayed in Japanese, just because you are in Japan. If you don't read Japanese characters, this can be quite puzzling and annoying.

What you can do

You can set your personal preference and set your preferred language.

First, click the Settings (wheel) icon in the upper-right corner of your Calendar page.

Then, click the 設定 (Settings) link.
