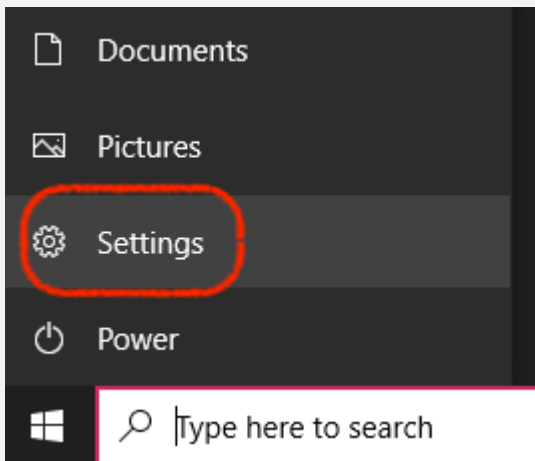


HOW TO ENABLE JAPANESE INPUT METHOD IN WINDOWS

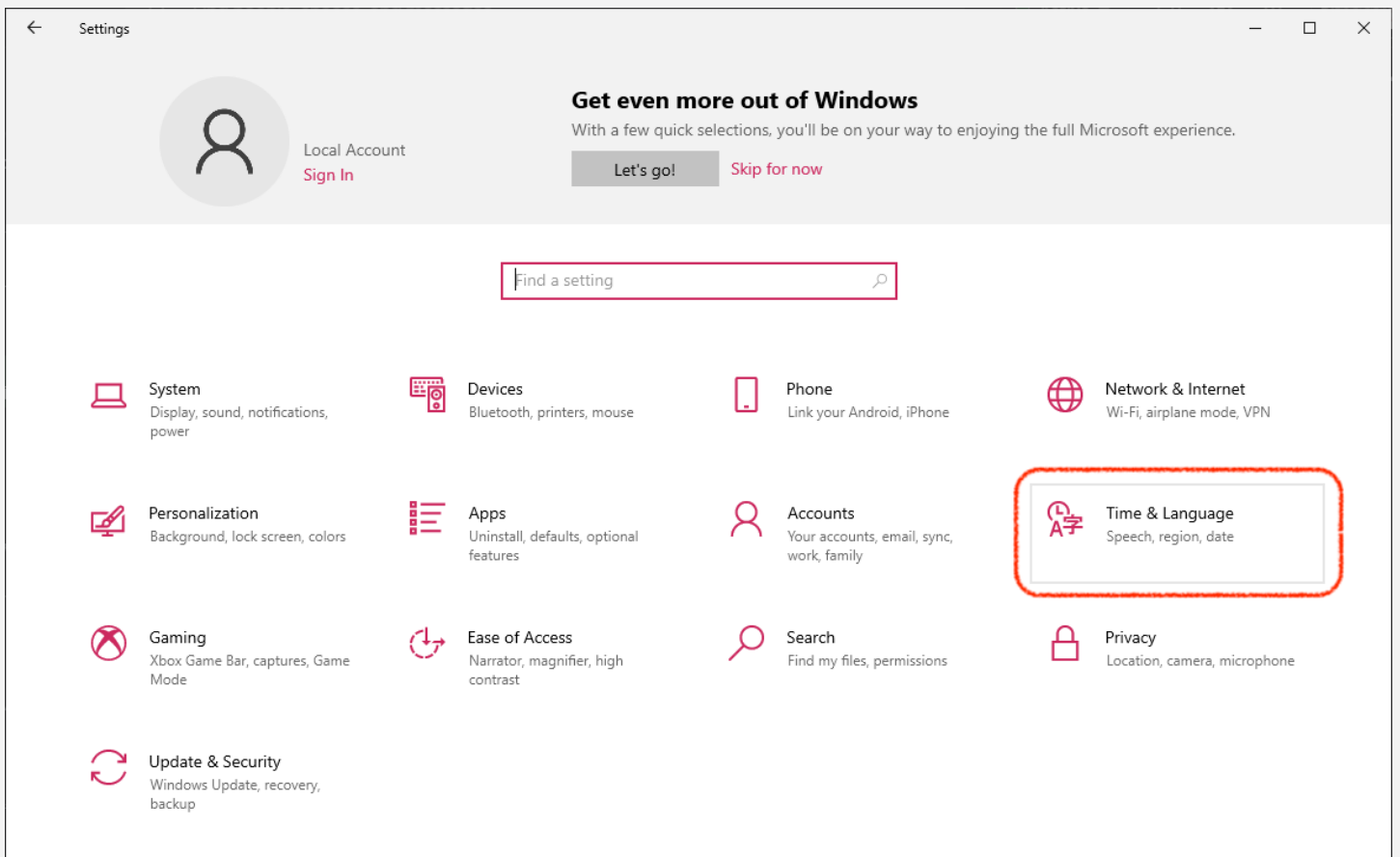

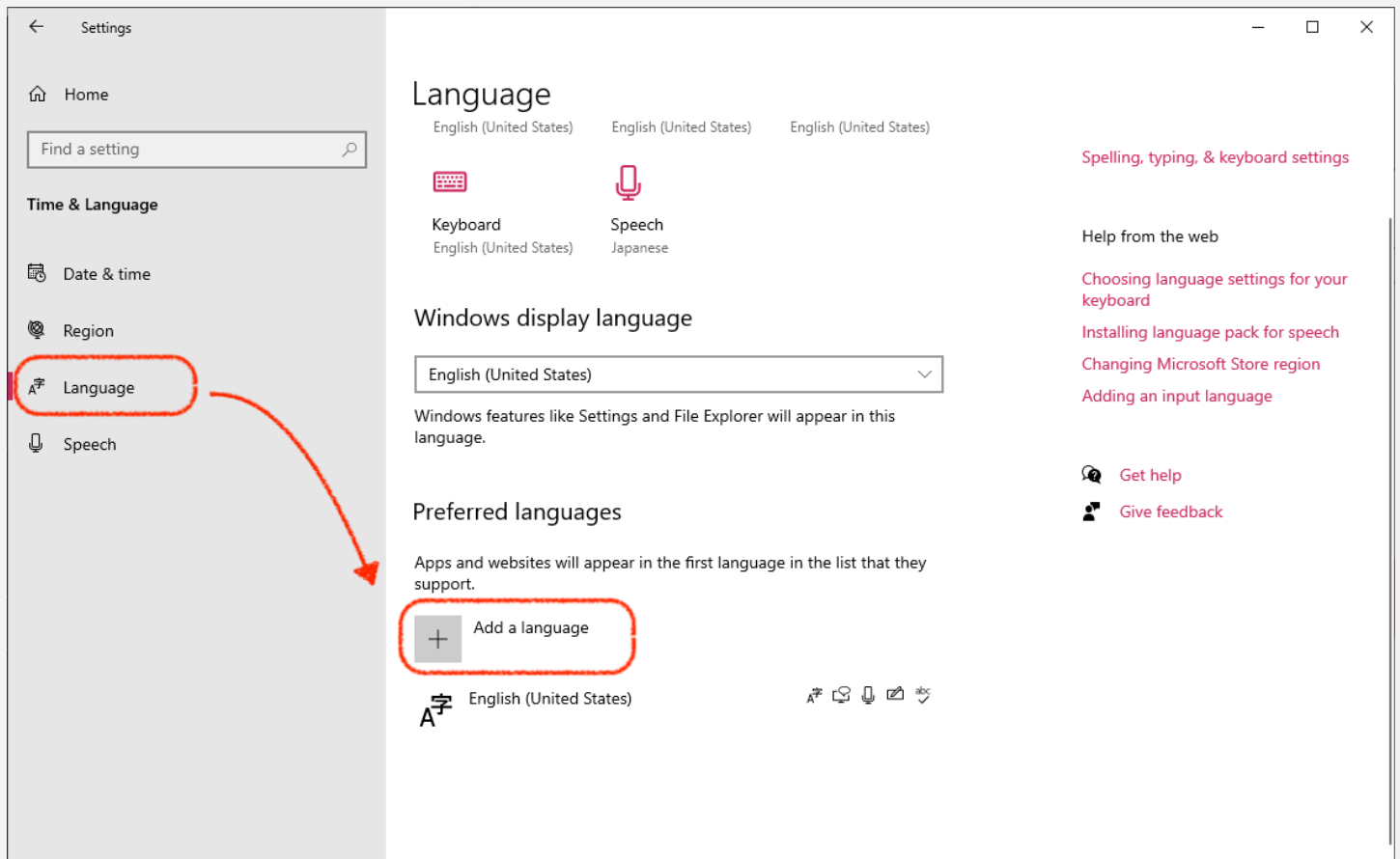
Click the Windows menu on the lower-end corner of your screen, and open Settings.



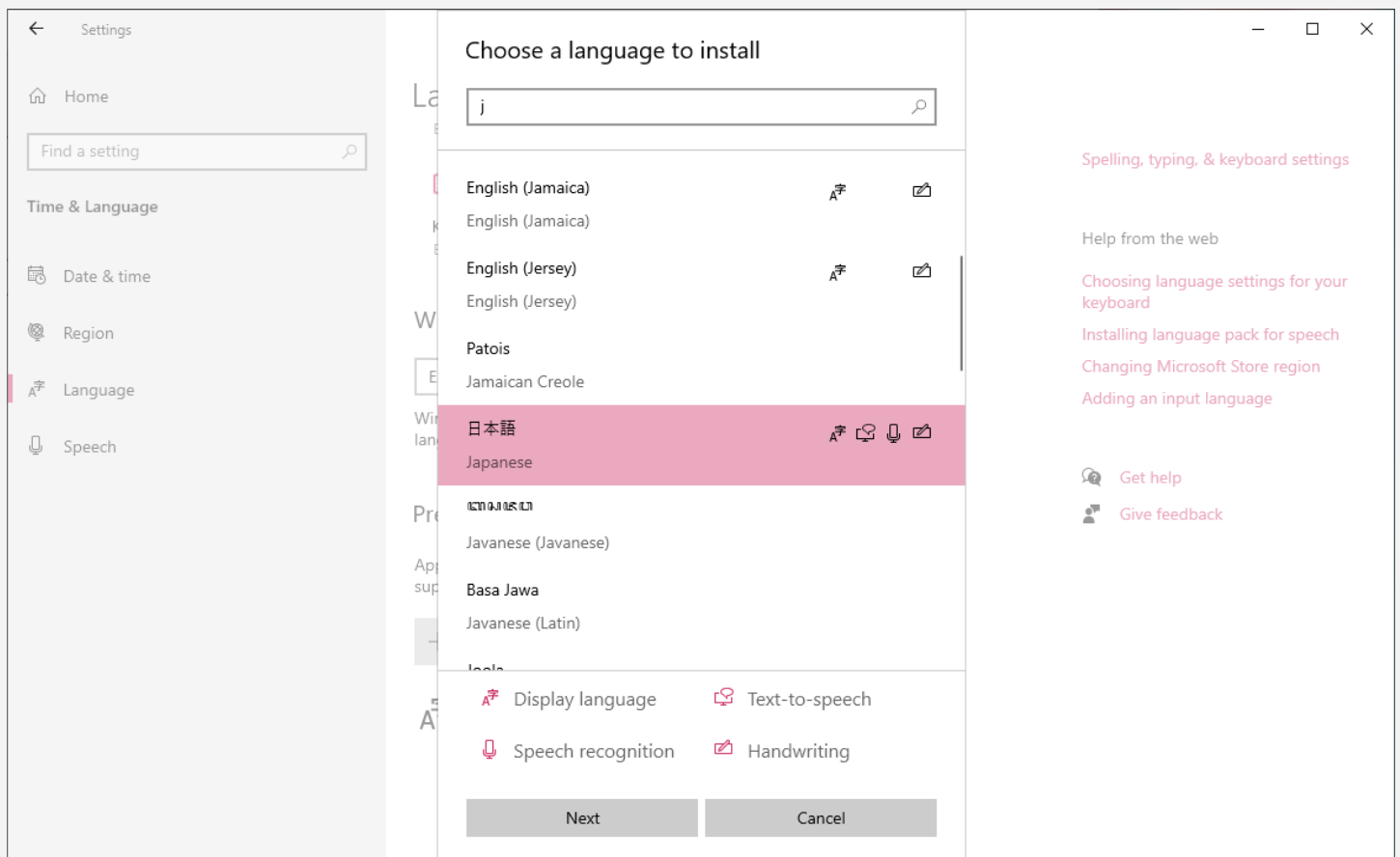
In Settings, open Time & Language.



In the Time & Language pane, click Language in the left column and click + Add a language under Preferred languages.

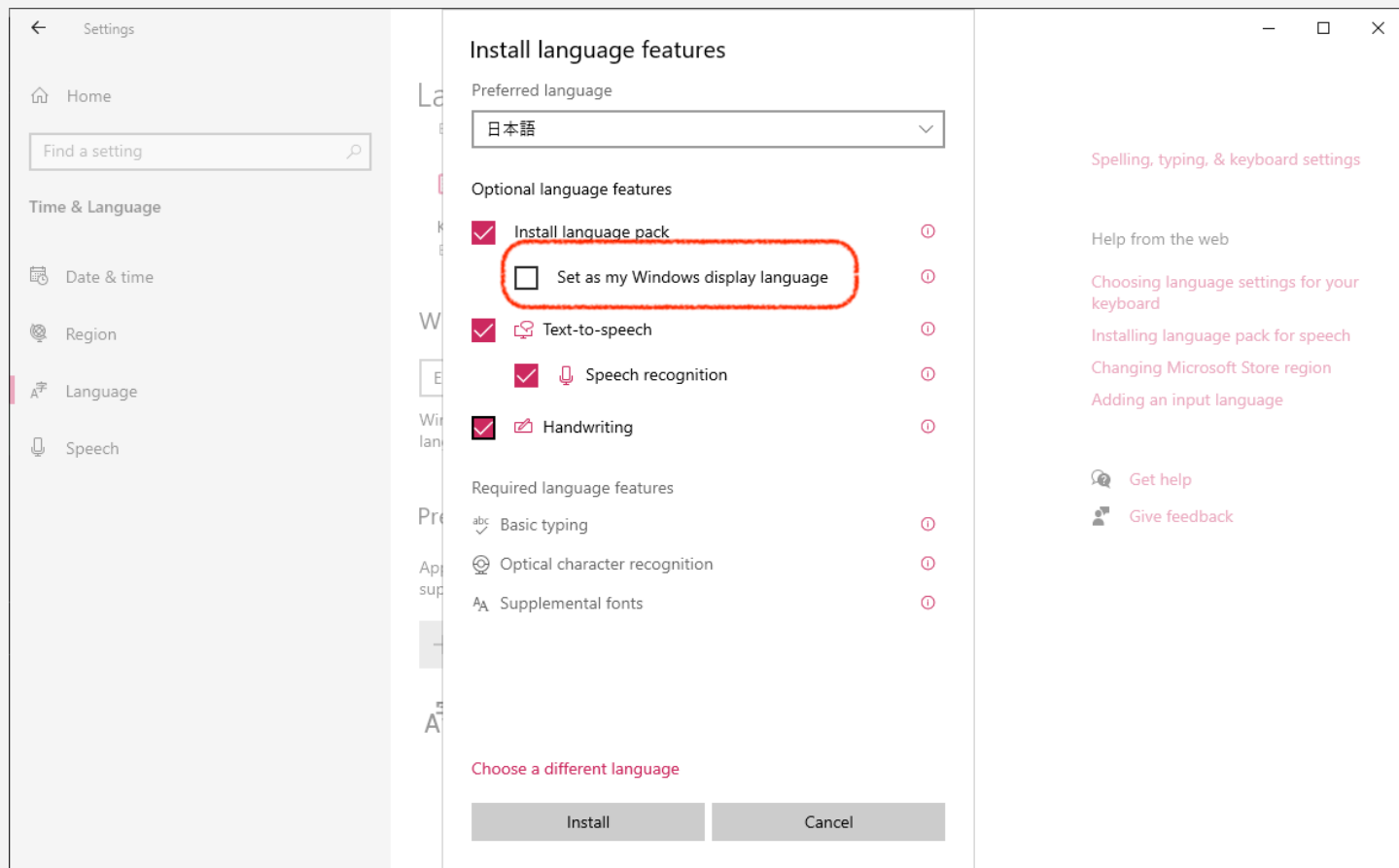


Select Japanese.

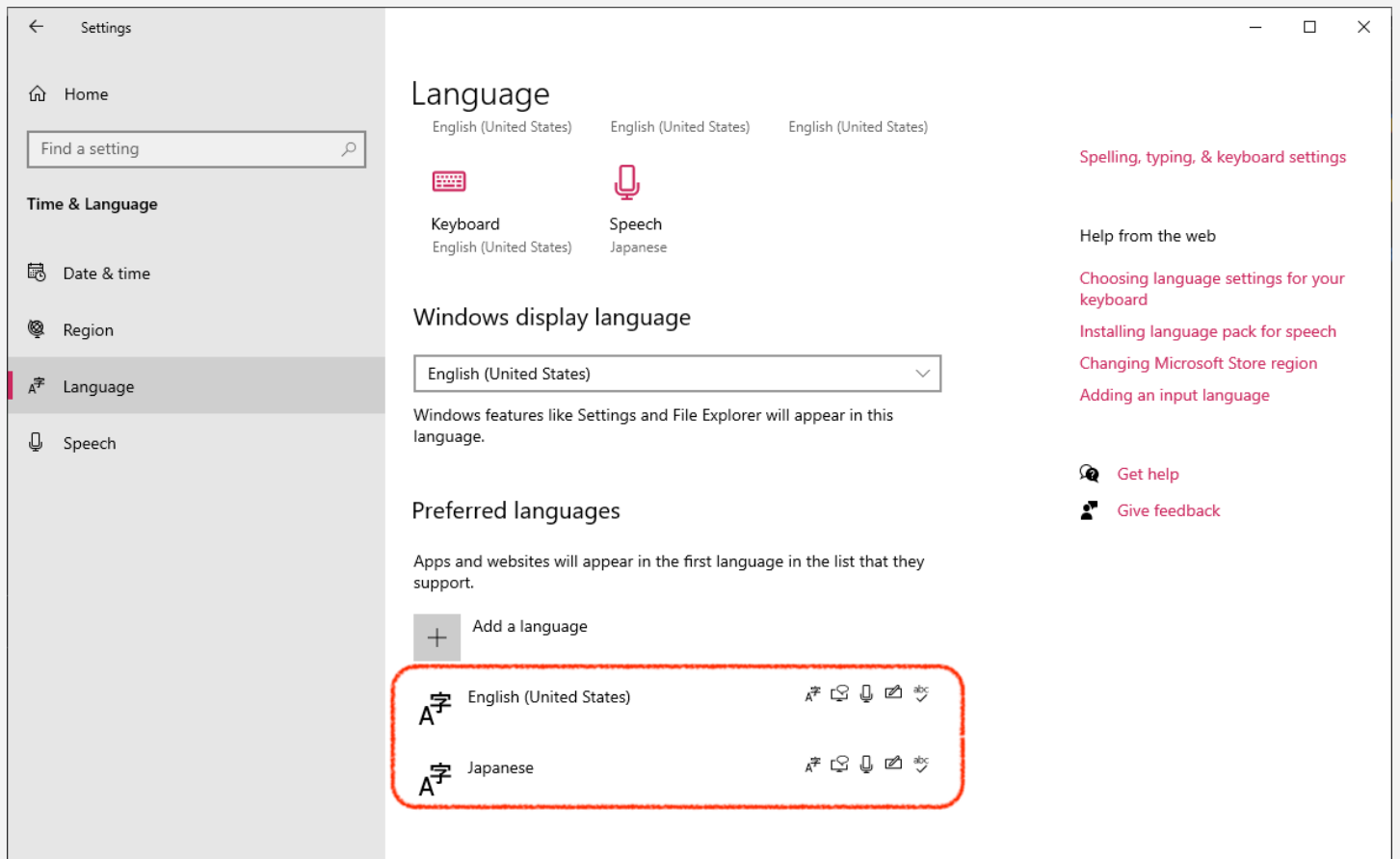


In the next window, install the language pack to enable Japanese input.

IMPORTANT: Keep “Set as my Windows display language” unchecked to keep your Windows OS in English or your own language. If you check this box, the entire Windows OS will be displayed in Japanese.



Japanese has been added to English (or your own language).



After this, you can switch between the Japanese and English input methods in your Task Bar.
